## LWV of Wisconsin Fifty-Ninth Convention

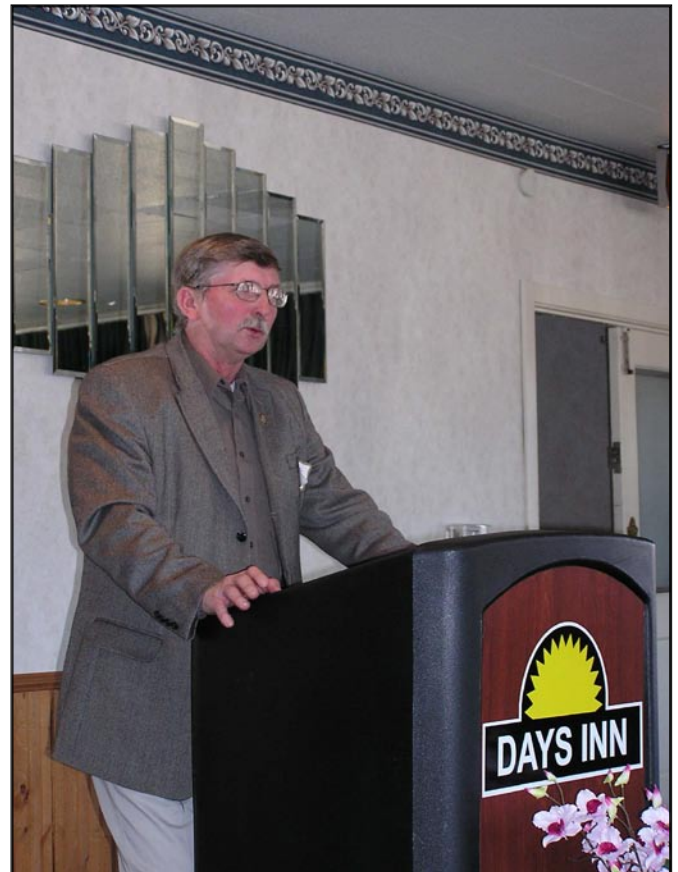

# League Legislative Breakfast 2005



Senator Dan Kapanke (above left), Rep. Jennifer Shilling (above right), and Rep. Lee Nerison (right) joined League members on Saturday, April 2 for the annual League Legislative Breakfast. Rep. Ron Kind did not attend, but a staff representative talked about issues of concern to Rep. Kind: greenhouse gas emissions; higher education and Pell Grants; and social security. Rep. Shilling talked about the state budget, health care; the minimum wage; and her concern about the Voter ID Bill. Senator Kapanke stressed that he is making an effort to reach out to the other side and expressed his concern about the tax load on citizens; he has not signed on yet to TABOR, but is studying it. Rep. Nerison focused on legislation and issues pertaining to agriculture, including AB145 (investment tax credit to livestock producers) and biodegradable fuels. Both Sen. Kapanke and Rep. Nerison shared their perspectives on what it is like to be newly elected to the Senate and Assembly respectively. As usual, there was a lively question session ranging from the state economy and budget to the “Conscience Clause” Bill..
